Opportunities at Cornwall Community Hospital

Pediatricians would join our level 1 community hospital with Pediatric and Obstetrical Units combined as Women's and Children Health Services.

Women and Children's Health Services offers 24/7 obstetrician coverage and paediatrician coverage for newborns, teenagers, and children.

Hospital on call paediatric coverage includes seeing healthy newborns, managing paediatric inpatients, seeing emergency consults at the request of the emergency physicians as well as attendance at delivery if requested.

Our Department works closely with the Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario (CHEO) in Ottawa who is also our referral center to help manage more complex patients.

Every year, our Labour and Delivery Unit helps to deliver nearly 600 babies from across Eastern Ontario.

Remuneration is currently fee for service through OHIP as well as an on-call stipend (HOCC).
