<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The Geriatric Day Hospital is a client centered, collaborative and rehabilitation focused program for seniors who require interdisciplinary professional care with a focus on <b>fall prevention</b> and <b>cognition</b>.</li> <li>➤ Referrals accepted from Family Physicians, Health Care Professionals and Community Agencies. They can be faxed directly to us. (ER physicians may request a GEM assessment).</li> <li>➤ The team includes a nurse practitioner, a physiotherapist, an occupational therapist &amp; a mental health counselor.</li> <li>➤ Clients must be 65 years of age and older, <b>willing and able to participate in a group setting 2 mornings a week for 10 weeks</b>, able to manage their own continence, medically stable enough to participate in an exercise program and require the services of at least two of our disciplines.</li> <li>➤ Our target population includes people who are at risk for falls, decreased function, memory/mood issues, isolation, safety concerns and or general deconditioning.</li> <li>➤ Through individual and group reconditioning, we strive to support the person in the community by promoting healthy living, achieve/maintain a level of independence, provide physical and cognitive exercise, encourage socialization, provide support and education and address medical, functional and social issues.</li> </ul>
